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Situated on a private islet on the secluded island of Isla Mujeres, six and a half miles northeast of Cancun, the Avalon Reef Club timeshare resort is truly defined by the beauty, enjoyment, relaxation and romance of being just footsteps from the sea. This unique, all-inclusive resort, accessible only by ferry, is strikingly different from other resorts. More a private island sanctuary than a stereotypical Mexican resort, here the warm trade winds, panoramic vistas, crystalline waters and sugar-white sand beaches produce dramatic a setting that is right out of a fairy tale.

The Avalon Reef Club is ideally suited for singles, couples and families looking to enjoy personalized service, outstanding amenities and total relaxation. However, it is the Reef Club's incredible location and limitless activities that will truly make you want to return year after year.

Isla Mujeres is a only twenty minutes away from Cancun but it is a world away in every way. Cancun is a modern mega resort and Isla Mujeres is a quiet, quaint fishing village. The Avalon Resorts have set it up so you can enjoy both properties in your exchange although you can book both resorts separately. It is highly recommended staying in both areas. It was like two separate holidays.

Isla Mujeres, the Island of Women, is located just eight miles across the Bahia de Mujeres (Bay of Women) from Cancun, Isla Mujeres is only 5 miles long and half a mile wide with a downtown area of just four by six blocks.

The location of the Avalon Reef is amazing. It is on its own private Island off the tip of Isla Mujeres. It is only accessible by a wooden bridge or by wading through waist deep water. On one side of the Island is open Caribbean ocean with the waves crashing against the rocks and on the other side are beautiful white beaches, calm water and sand bars so you can wade far off shore.

The resort is divided into a hotel section and a timeshare section. The modern hotel is about eight stories high and the timeshare units have a white washed villa look to them. There is a gym which included two or three cardio machines and a all-in-one weights machine. There is a also a spa in the hotel building. For a treat you may want to have the massage under the gazebo at the very tip of the Island. Kayaks and snorkel equipment is provided for free. The resort is only about a ten minute walk to town and we found our selves walking back and forth two or three times a day. It is recommended buying a good pair of walking sandals or rent a golf cart for your stay. The beaches are so attractive that we never did use the pool.

One neat thing is that the house on the water right next to the resort used to belong to Jacque Cousteau the famous scuba diver.
